Appointment of General Manager

The President and Toowoomba Golf Club Board of Directors are pleased to announce that Mr Ron Jadach has been appointed as the Club's General Manager. It is expected that Ron will commence on the 9 November, 2009.

Short Profile of Ron Jadach

Ron was born in America and moved to Australia nearly 20 years ago. He took out Australian citizenship before coming. He is married to Anna who is from Adelaide. They intend to move to Toowoomba and live here permanently. Anna has some business interests she needs to take care of before coming to Toowoomba permanently.

Ron grew up with golf. He learnt to play the game at an early age and played on his College team. He was at the University of Southern California with players like Mark O'Meara and Craig Stadler. He was a volunteer on the U.S. Pro Tour.

After coming to Australia Ron became Golf Services Manager at Sanctuary Cove. At the time it was in receivership and he had to promote and assist the Receivers to get the golf section of the Resort profitable. He was very successful and within four and a half years was Director of Golf there, a position he held for 8 years. He was responsible for the entire operation of the two 18 hole courses, management of over 30 staff, budgeting and financial management, marketing, course maintenance and presentation and running all tournaments including the 1993 and 1996 Australian Skins Tournament.

In 2003 Ron was appointed General Manager of Peregrine Springs Golf Club. He was fully involved in setting up the entire business including course changes, the establishment of a membership base, the setting up of the clubhouse, promotion and sales of membership shares, establishment of the business plan, budgeting and financial planning and staffing of this brand new club. He established a restaurant there, which won the Sunshine Coast Best Club Restaurant award and then the 2005 best Club Restaurant award run by the Restaurant and Caterers Association of Queensland. He successfully negotiated for the Club to hold the FKP Jack Newton Celebrity Classic. The Club also was also acknowledged by the PGA for holding one of the top three PGA Pro-Am tournaments in 2004.

After leaving Peregrine Springs he took a temporary assignment at Noosa Springs Club as Golf and Operation's Manager to get that club and resort's membership and golf promotion and course up to the standard required by the developers and management. He had a short stint at Flagstaff Hill Club in Adelaide as General Manager. Even though Anna was an Adelaide girl they preferred the Queensland lifestyle and returned to Queensland where Ron established his own consulting business until he accepted our offer to become our General Manager.
